

UNEXPECTED ACTION and exuberant expressions usually can be stopped when you set the \triangle shutter speed upwards of 1/100 second. Here everything is in focus from approximately six to fifteen feet. Whether you're shooting a street scene or sports events, it's a good idea to pre-set shutter, lens opening and focus. Then you can be sure of catching most actions that occur within the predetermined limits indicated on the depth of field scale of your camera.
